Health Care And Emergencies

The Golden Eagle Charter School Governance Council recognizes the importance of taking appropriate action whenever an emergency threatens the safety, health, or welfare of a person at school or during school-sponsored activities.

The Director or designee shall develop procedures to ensure that first aid and/or medical attention is provided as quickly as possible when accidents and injuries occur and that parents/guardians are notified as appropriate.

The Director or designee shall ask parents/guardians to provide emergency contact information in order to facilitate communication in the event of an accident or illness.

School staff shall appropriately report and document accidents.

Automated External Defibrillators

The Governance Council authorizes the placement of automated external defibrillators (AEDs) at designated school sites for use by designated personnel who have received training in the use of AEDs.

The Director or designee shall ensure that employees receive training on their proper use and handling.

The authorization of AEDs in Golden Eagle school sites shall not be deemed to create a guarantee or obligation to use the AED in the case of an emergency nor any expectation that an AED or trained employee will be present and/or able to use an AED in an emergency or any expectation that the AED will operate properly.
