

YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE

Winter can be enjoyed in many ways. At winter resorts you may see people using alpine, snowboard, Telemark, cross country or other specialized equipment such as that used by disabled or other skiers. Regardless of how you decide to enjoy the slopes, always show courtesy to others and be aware that there are elements of risk that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce.

1. ALWAYS STAY IN CONTROL. SKI OR BOARD IN SUCH A MANNER THAT YOU CAN STOP OR AVOID OTHER PEOPLE AND OBJECTS.
2. PEOPLE AHEAD OF YOU HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO AVOID THEM.
3. YOU MUST NOT STOP WHERE YOU OBSTRUCT A TRAIL OR ARE NOT VISIBLE FROM ABOVE.
4. WHENEVER STARTING DOWNHILL OR WHEN MERGING INTO A TRAIL, LOOK UPHILL AND YIELD TO OTHERS.
5. ALWAYS USE DEVICES TO HELP PREVENT RUNAWAY EQUIPMENT.
6. OBSERVE ALL POSTED SIGNS AND WARNINGS. KEEP OFF CLOSED TRAILS AND OUT OF CLOSED AREAS.
7. PRIOR TO USING ANY LIFT, YOU MUST HAVE KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITY TO LOAD AND UNLOAD SAFELY.

SMART STYLE

1. LOOK BEFORE YOU LEAP. Scope around the jumps first, not over them. Know your landings are clear and clear yourself out of the landing area
2. EASY STYLE IT. Start small and work your way up. Inverted aerial not recommended.
3. RESPECT GETS RESPECT. From the lift lines through the terrain park.

TRAIL SIGNS

BE AWARE OF WHAT THESE TRAIL SIGNS MEAN AND THAT THEY ARE MEANT TO HELP YOU STAY WITHIN YOUR ABILITY LEVEL.

MORE DIFFICULT
(Blue Square)

MOST DIFFICULT
(Black Diamond)

FREESTYLE
(Orange oval)
